

Campers will tell stories around the campfire, roast marshmallows, sing songs, sleep in tents and have a night in and among nature.



BUS AND BUNK ASSIGNMENTS will be e-mailed in early June.

MEDICAL and DENTAL – Please make sure to send in your Medical Forms. Also, we suggest that your dentist examines your child's teeth **now** to prevent trouble during the summer. If orthodontic appliances are worn, have a final check-up in the event of a necessary adjustment.


LETTERS HOME – Campers must write home twice a week. **ONE-WAY CAMPER EMAIL** – See information on page 7. **TWEET/BLOG** – See information on page 8.

PHONE CALLS – Campers may call home on the time you select beginning July 3. See page 23.

BIRTHDAYS – If a camper's birthday occurs during the camp season, Chen-A-Wanda will automatically provide a birthday cake for your camper and his/her birthday will be celebrated in the dining room. See Birthday Information on page 19.

FOOD PACKAGES – We strictly enforce our policy of <u>NOT ALLOWING</u> our campers & staff to RECEIVE ANY FOOD PACKAGES including water or any kind of drink packets to be added to bottled water. The only exception to this is the following 3 products:

- Maruchan Instant Lunch Chicken Flavor (in a cup)
- Cup Noodles Chicken (in a cup)





THESE ARE THE ONLY 3 PRODUCTS ALLOWED and they MUST BE SENT **WITH a PACKAGE LABEL.** Your camper's name must be on the individual item. See Package Policy on page 9.

ELECTRONIC GUIDELINES – We strictly enforce our policy of any camper found <u>not following</u> the rules on small electronics will lose the privilege of having these items in camp and the item(s) will be sent home at the parents' expense.

□ CAMPERS ARE <u>PERMITTED</u> TO BRING <u>SMALL ELECTRONIC ITEMS</u>. such as PSP's[®], iPods[®] (not iPod Touch[®])[,] Cameras etc.

CAMPERS ARE <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> TO BRING <u>TV's, CELL PHONES or any device that can</u> <u>access the internet</u>. See page 10 for a complete list of prohibited items.

ELECTRONIC RULES

<u>CAMERAS</u>

Cameras <u>may only be used</u> outside of the bunk on the camp grounds or during trips. Picture taking is <u>not permitted inside of the bunk</u> at any time.

• <u>PSP's[®], iPODS[®] SIMILAR ITEMS</u>

These electronic items <u>must only be used in the bunk</u> unless a Head Counselor has given permission to the camper to use it for a specific occasion outside of the bunk. Please make sure any of these acceptable items are labeled and that your child knows that he/she <u>must be</u> <u>extremely careful with these items</u>. Chen-A-Wanda <u>cannot</u> replace any items that are lost or damaged.

Summer 2010 begins Saturday, June 26th ...

<u>CAMPERS TRAVEL TO CAMP</u> on air-conditioned coach buses equipped with bathrooms. Directions regarding departure times, and pickup points will be emailed to you.

Directions to the bus pick-up areas will also be posted on the web.

BUS TRIP - CAMPERS SHOULD BRING SANDWICHES and DRINKS.

Upon arrival at Camp the campers will be served fruit, milk, and cookies.

CAMPERS ARE PERMITTED TO BRING SPORTS EQUIPMENT ON

THE BUS. Other last minute items that have not shipped may also be sent, however **NO TRUNKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE BUS.**

AT THE BUS STOP

PLEASE GIVE a HEAD COUNSELOR or a DIRECTOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:



- Special instructions for **the medical staff** and **health and insurance forms**, if not already sent to camp.
- **Medicines or serums for injection** with instructions which are properly labeled from the pharmacy and directions included with the medicine and on the child's health form.

If your child's medication(s) needs refrigeration <u>PLEASE</u> inform the head counselor or director that you give your item(s) to so they can put it into the cooler immediately.



Your Camper(s) MUST have their <u>MEDICAL and INSURANCE CARD Forms</u> <u>COMPLETED and SIGNED by the FIRST DAY OF CAMP (JUNE 26th)</u> Your Child CANNOT and <u>WILL NOT</u> be TREATED if the forms have not been received by the Health Center STAFF.

• <u>Any special instructions for counselors</u> or <u>any forms</u> or <u>permission slips</u> that have not been returned as of yet, such as phone call scheduling, personal money requests, and/or birthday pizza party forms should be handed in to a **Head Counselor** or **Director** at the bus.

ARRIVAL AT CAMP – When campers arrive at Camp they will find their clothing unpacked, their beds made and activities ready to begin.

To set up a new account and visit our Online Community:

- 3. Click "Register Now"
- 4. Enter your Pre-Approved Registration Code: 5909CN1
- 5. Fill out all the required information (Your account comes with 10 Bunk Note Credits)
- 6. Purchase Additional Bunk Note credits (you will need a credit card-Optional)
- 7. Send an email to your camper!

* If you cannot find this button, go to <u>www.CampChenAWanda.bunk1.com</u> instead and continue on to the next step. For your camper's safety, please do not share the Pre-Approved Registration code above.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I send a Bunk Note (one-way email) to my camper?

Follow the instructions above except, after registering, simply sign in and click on the Bunk Notes button. Enter your camper's name, select the correct cabin, type your message, and hit the "Send" button.

Why do I have to pay to send Bunk Notes (one-way email)?

Each morning, the Bunk Notes system bundles and sorts the messages for us to print out and distribute to campers. It also protects us from computer viruses and allows us to easily manage these emails. Your payment helps us cover the cost of the system, paper, ink, and labor and, more importantly, frees us to do what we do best – be with your kids! Bunk Note credits cost \$1 each and are purchased in packs of various sizes.

Can other relatives use these services?

Certainly, once you have set up your account, you will be able to invite other people to access these services.

What do I do if I lost my username and password?

You can get it online by going to www.Bunk1.com and clicking on the link "Lost Your Password?" (to the left of the page below the sign in button). You will receive an email with your username and password within a few minutes.

PACKAGE/LETTER INSTRUCTIONS

CHEN-A-WANDA SECURITY MAILING LABELS -

You will receive <u>3 security mailing labels</u> for the <u>3 packages</u> that are accepted for each camper per summer. Campers may receive items that you think they would like as

long as they are not on CAW's prohibited list (page 10).

Do not lose or misplace these labels as they are needed for your child's packages. Labels should be on all packages even packages sent directly by a store, priority mail and express mail packages delivered by USPS, UPS, FedEx or any other mailing services.

Please don't put candy into a magazine, a book, a stuffed animal, a tennis ball can, clothing, etc. Our office staff will not give candy or anything else on the prohibited list to your camper (page 10).

A PACKAGE DOES NOT NEED A LABEL ...

1. When sending <u>NECESSITIES</u>

Just alert the office for anything that you deem to be an emergency item (glasses, contact lenses, sports items, etc.) and then send the package <u>without</u> the CAW label.

Address the package to your child with their Bunk Letter in the lower left hand corner of the package. Send to the attention of: Nancy Berman (Office Manager). Please be sure to <u>only include the</u> <u>emergency item</u> (no little extras).

Baked Goods, Bottled Water, All Sports Drinks (liquid or powdered) may not be sent to camp.

*Easy Mac (in a cup) and CupNoodles Chicken and Maruchan Instant Lunch Chicken Flavor will be permitted (see page 5) and must have your child's name on the package.

PROHIBITED ITEMS SENT TO CAMPERS WILL NOT BE RETURNED

**SENIORS CELL PHONE POLICY

Seniors may bring their cell phones on the Hershey trip.

- This is the only trip that cell phones will be allowed.
- Phones should be brought to camp on Visiting Day and given to Nancy in the main office.
- Phones brought to camp before Visiting Day will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and then given to your child for the Hershey trip.*
- Please **label** the **phone** and the **charger** with your child's name.
- Remember You will be unable to get your child's phone on visiting day.

** SUPERS, GCs, CIT's, WAITRESSES/WAITERS CELL PHONE POLICY

Supers and GCs may bring their cell phones on the Cleveland trip.

- This is the only trip that cell phones will be allowed.
- Phones should be brought to camp on Visiting Day and given to Nancy in the main office.
- Phones brought to camp before Visiting Day will be collected, checked in upon arrival at camp and then given to your child for the Cleveland trip.*
- Please **<u>label</u>** the **<u>phone</u>** and the **<u>charger</u>** with your child's name.
- Remember You will be unable to get your child's phone on visiting day.

<u>CIT's, Waitresses / Waiters are permitted to use cell phones</u> on their Days Off & the Cleveland trip.

- Phones will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and distributed to the campers on each day off and for the Cleveland trip.
- The cell phones will be collected by the Group Leader after the day off and after the Cleveland trip.
- Please **label** the **cell phone** and **charger** with your child's name.
- Remember You will be unable to get your child's phone on visiting day.

CAMPER PERSONAL ACCOUNTS

Each camper has a **PERSONAL ACCOUNT** set up for them in the main office. This money is used:

- on day trips for purchasing extra refreshments or souvenirs.
- to purchase batteries, stamps, and sundries in camp.
- to buy bottled water, Snapple, soda, etc. in camp. (A **maximum of \$3.00** per day can be withdrawn by the camper from their account for drink money).

We recommend that campers should <u>not</u> keep money in their bunk. If a camper brings cash to camp or receives a check in the mail, he/she should deposit the money in his/her **PERSONAL ACCOUNT** in the Main Office. Please remind him/her that this account is to protect his/her money from getting lost, etc.

For each trip we give your camper the amount of money you indicate on your Personal <u>Account Form</u> for the specific trip (pages 12 -17).

We suggest opening your child's personal account with <u>the amount that you calculate</u> on your child's Personal Account Form (Column C) or a minimum of \$200 (\$250 for golfers).

You may check the balance of your child's account at any time by calling the main office. This account may be replenished on Visiting Day or by simply mailing a check to us during the summer. Any money remaining at the end of the summer will be sent home to you.

Please fill out a separate Personal Account Trip Request form for each camper.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH FOR THE PERSONAL ACCOUNT. <u>CHECKS SHOULD BE</u> <u>MADE OUT TO CAMP CHEN-A-WANDA.</u> PLEASE WRITE CAMPER ACCOUNT followed by your CHILD'S FIRST and LAST NAME in the <u>MEMO</u> section of the check.
